How do we calculate our Live Release Rate?

Humane Animal Rescue uses the Shelter Animals Count Data Matrix to report our animal data. The Live Release Rate is an Asilomar formula that most shelters use. Rates are computed by dividing Total Live Outcomes by Total Outcomes, less Owner Requested Euthanasia.

Asilomar "Lite" Live Release Rate Formula:

$(\text{Live Outcomes}) \div (\text{All Outcomes} - \text{Owner Requested Euthanasia})$

This formula is the same as the Asilomar Live Release Rate with one exception – it adjusts All Outcomes by subtracting all Owner Requested Euthanasias, not only those Owner Requested Euthanasia's identified upon admission as "unhealthy/untreatable". This formula is an Asilomar-type option for those organizations or communities without the capacity to assign a conditions status for animals admitted (i.e. "healthy," "treatable," "unhealthy/untreatable").
