

Project Volunteer

OBJECTIVE: The Project Volunteer opportunity is a woodworking and maintenance focused position. Individuals will have different options available depending upon the need of the Humane Animal Rescue Wildlife Center. Available projects change frequently, please contact the Volunteer Manager.

ENVIRONMENT:

- Indoors or outdoors – will be exposed to all weather conditions.
- May work alongside other volunteers, medical interns, and staff members
- Projects may also be available to occur off-site.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES:

- Must be able to lift at least 30 pounds.
- Must be able to use foot stool or ladder.
- Must be able to use basic hand tools; dexterity is recommended.
- Must be able to be on foot/stand for extended periods of time.
- May be required to use paints.
- May be exposed to hot or cold temperatures

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Valid tetanus vaccine is recommended.
- Will be required to follow directions, and take correction as needed.
- Must be drug free and may be subject to a criminal background check.
- Must love wildlife and getting dirty!

RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Constructing cages, hutches, aviaries.
- Cleaning indoor or outdoor areas.
- Painting.
- Pressure washing caging.
- Moving gravel or soil.
- Hanging shade cloth, linens.
- Organizing storage areas.
- Covering perches.
