

Quality Care Volunteer/ Team

OBJECTIVE: The Quality Care Volunteer opportunity is a cleaning position. Individuals are required to wash dishes and assist with the laundry. This position does not work directly with animals.

ENVIRONMENT:

- Indoors. Kitchen and diet prep area.
- Will be working alongside other volunteers, medical interns, and staff members.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES:

- Must be able to lift at least 10 pounds.
- Must be able to routinely bend over.
- Must be able to be on foot/stand for at least 2 hours.
- Must be able to withstand hot and cold temperatures.
- Will be required to use detergents and bleach.
- Position is not recommended for those overly sensitive to strong odors, wounded animals, and carrion.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- If aged 13-15, must be accompanied by parent/guardian every shift.
- Must be able to provide medical documentation of a valid tetanus vaccine.
- Must complete all designated training.
- Must be willing to read the ARL Wildlife Center's Volunteer Handbook and adhere to all of the HAR Wildlife Center's policies and procedures.
- Will be required to follow directions, and take correction as needed.
- Must be drug free and will be subject to a criminal background check.
- Must be able to commit to a 2 hour weekly shift for at least 6 months
- Must love wildlife and getting dirty!

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Cleaning, washing, drying and putting away dishes.
- Washing, drying and putting away laundry.
- Organizing and labeling donations.
- Assisting in diet preparation.
- ***Every applicant is not guaranteed acceptance into the Humane Animal Rescue Wildlife Center. The Humane Animal Rescue also maintains the right to dismiss individuals at any time.**
